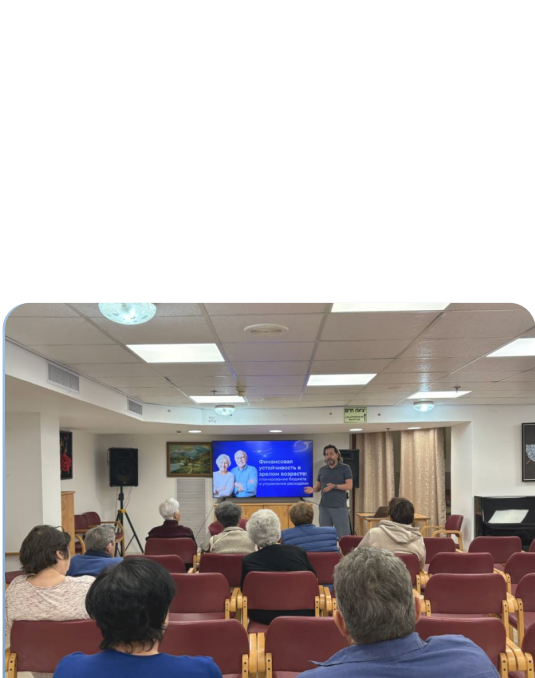


Activity Report of the Yad Yitzchok Charitable Foundation for January — March 2026

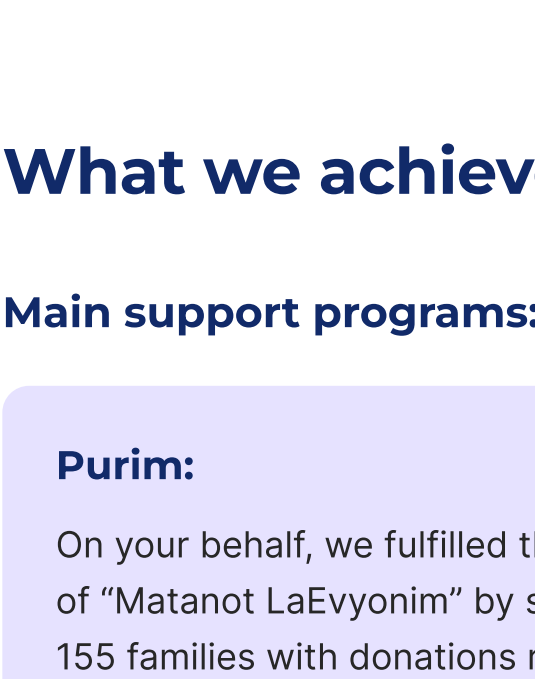
Main Events of Q1:



✓ During Purim, we fulfilled the mitzvah of “Matanot LaEvyonim” on your behalf for 155 families. The amount of each donation was calculated individually (from 500 to 1,500 shekels).

✓ The war with Iran continues to affect the lives of our beneficiaries.

✓ As part of our targeted assistance program, we supported 32 families, including those affected during the war, with a total amount of 375,979 shekels.



✓ At the same time, the Russian-language psychological support and consultation hotline continued operating. During the quarter, 97 requests directly related to the war and its consequences were processed.

✓ The Financial Literacy School continues to operate as a permanent program of the foundation. In Q1, three offline groups completed the course, while two more are still studying. The course is also available online.

What we achieved from January to March 2026

Main support programs:

Purim:

On your behalf, we fulfilled the mitzvah of “Matanot LaEvyonim” by supporting 155 families with donations ranging from 500 to 1,500 shekels. Total amount of assistance — 111,035 shekels.

IDF soldiers:

10 soldiers serving in combat units received assistance with requested equipment, as well as support for personal requests and humanitarian needs. Total amount — 80,153 shekels.

Shabbaton for lone soldiers:

35 lone soldiers took part in the Shabbaton. The total cost of the program amounted to 37,544 shekels.

Rapid response teams (“Kitot Konenut”):

80 volunteers from civilian emergency squads operating under the coordination of the Israel Police received support. Amount of assistance — 131,632 shekels.

Weddings:

Thanks to your support, 6 couples celebrated their weddings with the help of the foundation. Total amount — 45,113 shekels.

Targeted assistance:

As part of individual support, 32 families received targeted financial assistance, including families affected during the war with Iran. Total amount — 375,979 shekels.

Hotline during the war with Iran:

The hotline launched during the first days of the war continues to operate, providing psychological support and consultations in Russian. During the quarter, 97 requests directly related to the war and its consequences were processed.

Yad Yitzchok foundation initiatives:

In addition to direct and emergency assistance for those in need, the foundation develops long-term initiatives. These initiatives improve the standard of our work and help immigrants adapt to life in Israel, including through a financial literacy course.

We stay by our beneficiaries’ side not only during difficult moments, but also as they confidently build their future.

“Smart Chesed” program

The “Smart Chesed” program is focused on legal assistance, support with benefits and allowances, as well as social support for families and individuals facing difficult life situations.

Beneficiaries receive not just one-time financial aid, but ongoing support: assistance with obtaining entitled benefits, securing payments, understanding their rights, and avoiding unnecessary expenses.

- ★ **Actual assistance** provided through the project during Q1 2026 amounted to **769,300 shekels**.
- ★ **Long-term confirmed benefits** (over 1 year) — an additional **156,000 shekels**.
- ★ **Potential assistance** through other submitted applications may reach **264,000 shekels**.
- ★ Expenses for the “Smart Chesed” program amounted to **54,443 shekels**.

Financial adaptation: step by step

Financial literacy school “Learn to Count Again”

In Q1 2026, the offline course continued operating as a permanent program of the foundation. Three groups completed the course, while two more continue their studies. In total, 135 people participated in the offline course during the quarter.

The online format is also available: during the quarter, 879 people visited the school’s website, and 26 of them purchased the course.

Expenses for the financial literacy school amounted to **69,360 shekels**.

Telegram channel “Cozy Shekel”

Over three months, the channel grew to **11,613 subscribers**. Total post views during the quarter reached **581.9 thousand**.

We held **2 webinars** on relevant topics, attended by **180 people**:

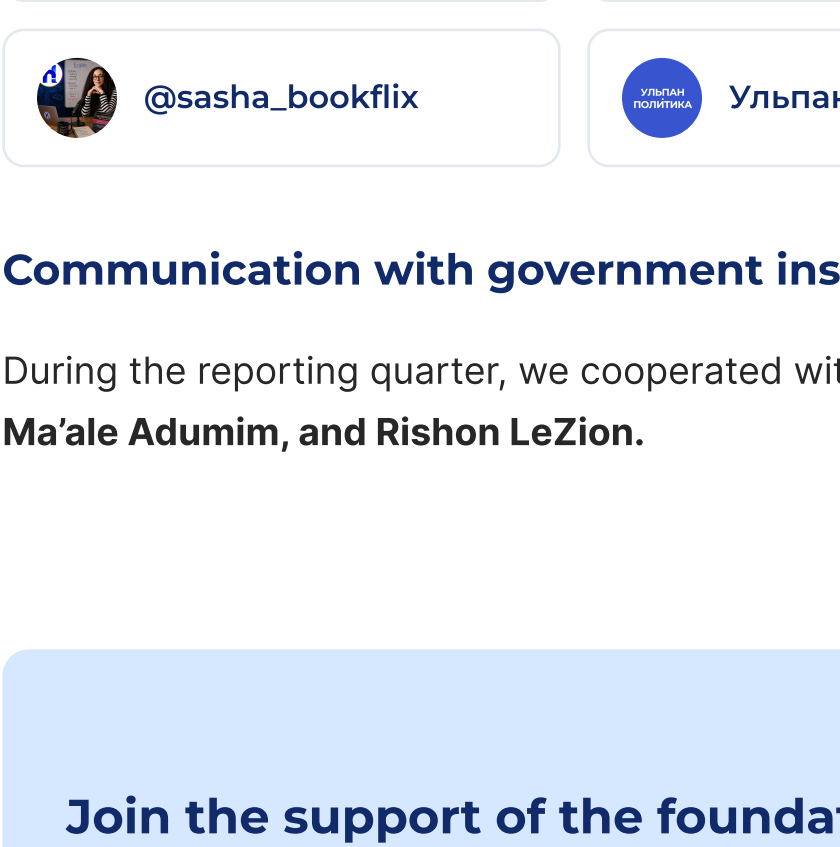

We continue to share the foundation’s work publicly. This helps new beneficiaries find us and builds a supportive community around our projects.

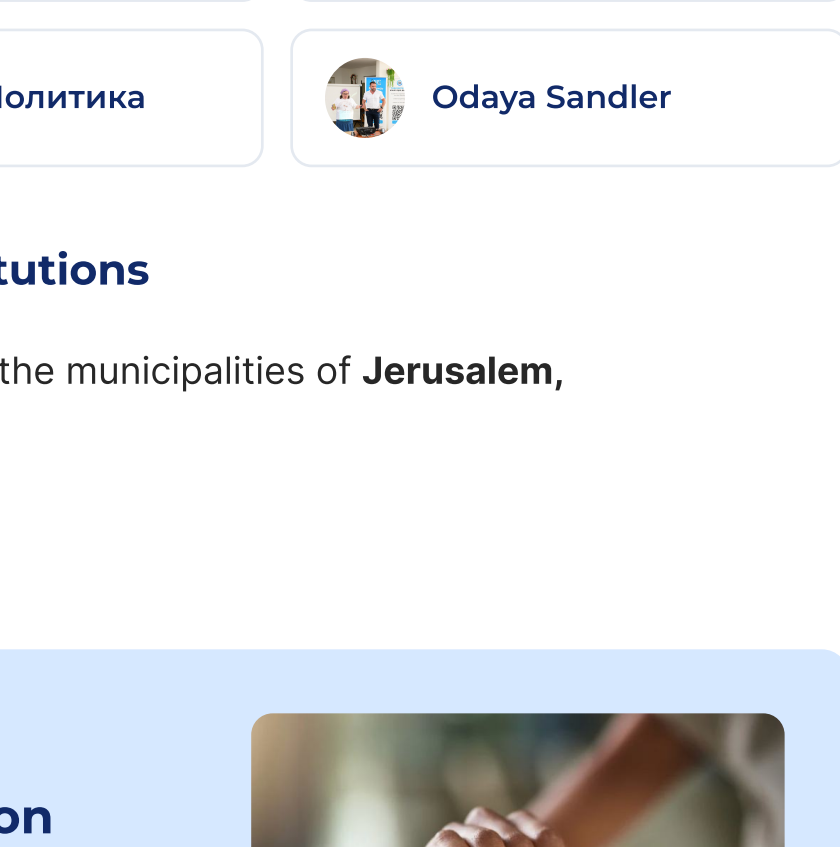

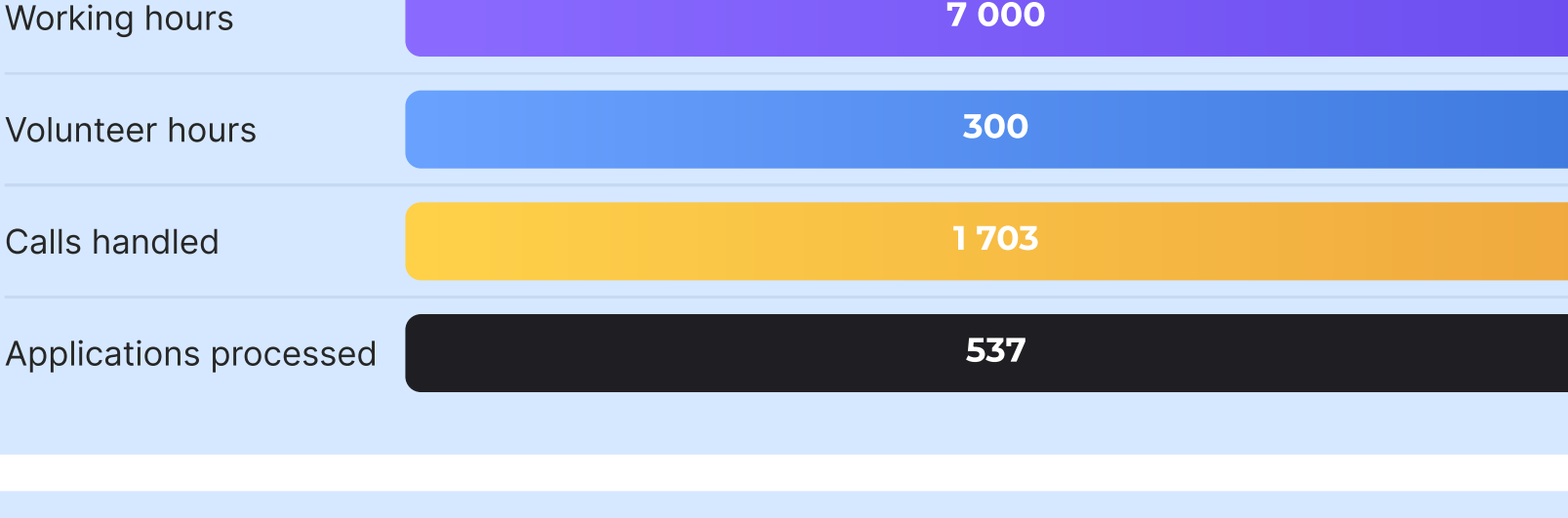
