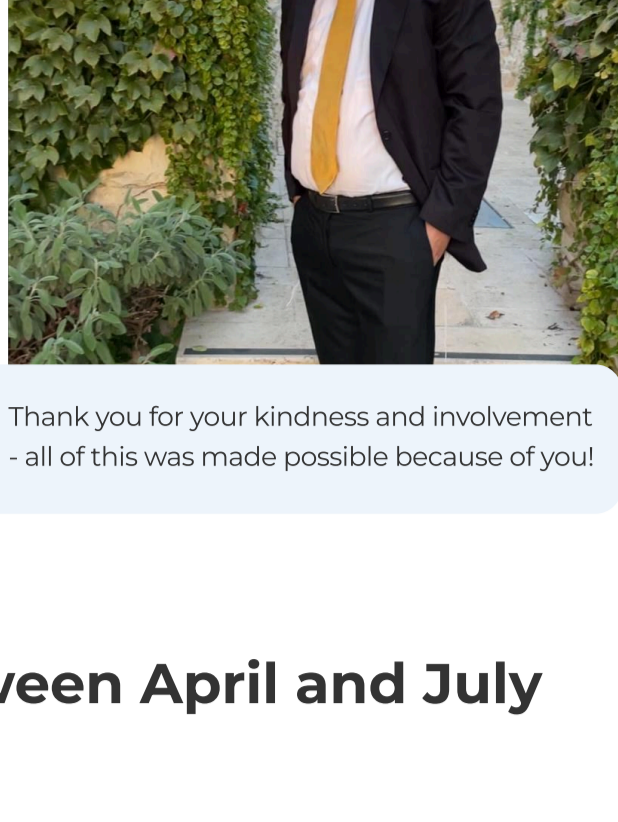


Activity report of the Yad Yitzchok charitable foundation for April - July 2025

Dear friends and partners of the foundation!

In the **second quarter** of this year, we were once again reminded of how much good can be done when caring people stand together. The support you provide to the **Yad Yitzchok charitable foundation forms** a strong and reliable foundation for an ever-growing number of **meaningful** and kind initiatives. We strive to act swiftly and precisely where it's most needed – **whether it's during holidays, emergencies, support for soldiers, or long-term projects for assisting new immigrants**. At the same time, we continue building a sustainable **support platform** that will keep serving our **community** in the future.

What was accomplished between April and July 2025?

Key support programs:

- ✔ **Pesach:** Ahead of the holiday, **93 families** received financial assistance.
- ✔ **Shavuot:** Support was provided to **42 families**.
- ✔ **Food sale:** We took part in a pre-holiday sale for low-income families and supported **260 families in need**.
- ✔ **IDF soldiers:** **350 combat unit soldiers** received food assistance and gear upon request.
- ✔ **Targeted assistance:** As part of our individual support efforts, we provided direct material aid to **30 families**.
- ✔ **Support during the war with Iran:** We launched a dedicated emergency hotline and directly handled **483 requests** related to the war and its consequences. People received psychological and legal assistance.

Independent initiatives of the Yad Yitzchok foundation

In addition to **regular or emergency aid for those in need**, the Yad Yitzchok charitable foundation actively develops **systemic initiatives** aimed at significantly **improving the quality of support provided**, as well as **helping new immigrants** adapt and increase their **financial literacy**.

We remain by the side of our beneficiaries not only to help them cope with **current challenges**, but also to enable them to **confidently build their future**.

Smart Chesed Program

"**he Smart Chesed**" program focuses on providing legal assistance, support in applying for benefits and subsidies, as well as comprehensive social aid for families and individuals facing difficult life circumstances.

The project continues to help beneficiaries receive not only one-time aid but also ongoing systemic support: securing entitlements, obtaining rightful payments, avoiding unnecessary expenses, and understanding their rights.

- **The actual assistance** provided through the project in Q2 2025 **amounted to 493,200 shekels**.
- **The approved** benefits will be paid to beneficiaries for an average of 3–5 years, with some granted for life. As a result, the project's long-term impact has secured families additional value exceeding **880,000 shekels**.
- **Potential support** from other submitted applications could bring in up to an additional **550,000 shekels**.

Financial adaptation: step by step

- During the reporting quarter, the school's website was visited **by 662 people**, of whom **35** completed the course.
- The program continues to serve as a reliable entry point into Israel's financial system for new immigrants.

Telegram channel "Cozy Shekel"

- Over the course of 3 months, **650 new** members joined the channel, bringing the total number of subscribers **to 9,280**.
- Over the quarter, we gathered **270,500 views**, held **4 webinars** and **one offline event**, with a total of **437 participants**.

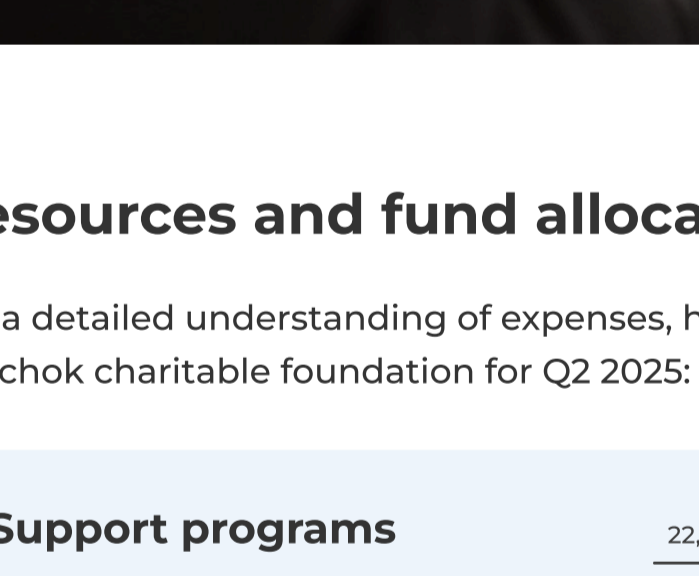

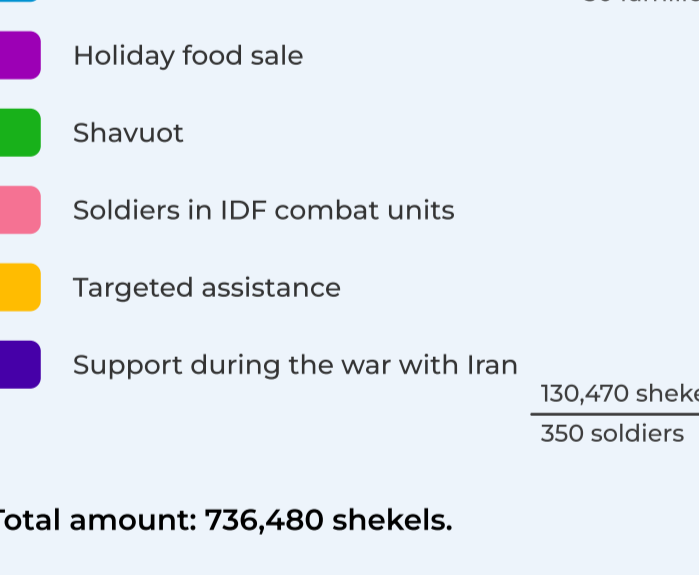
Public relations and communications

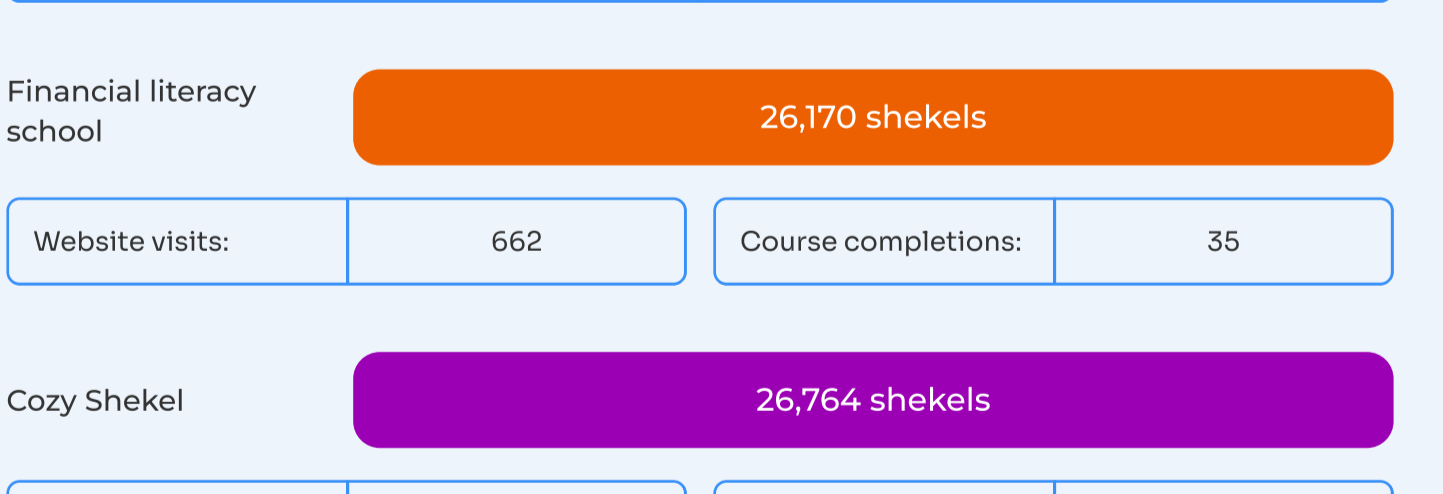
