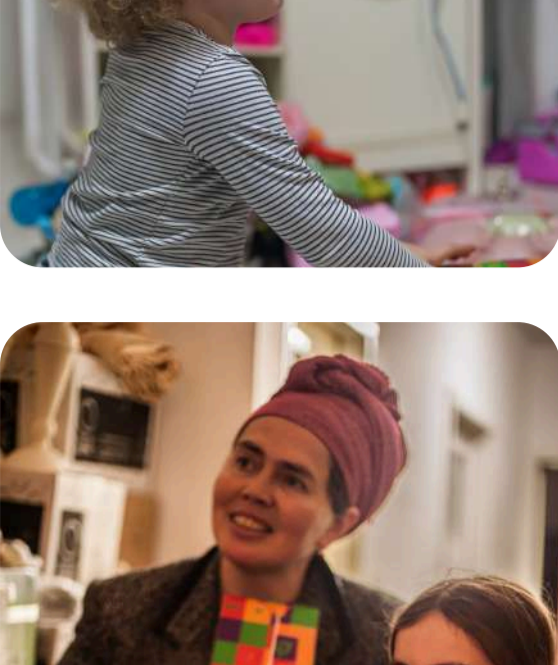

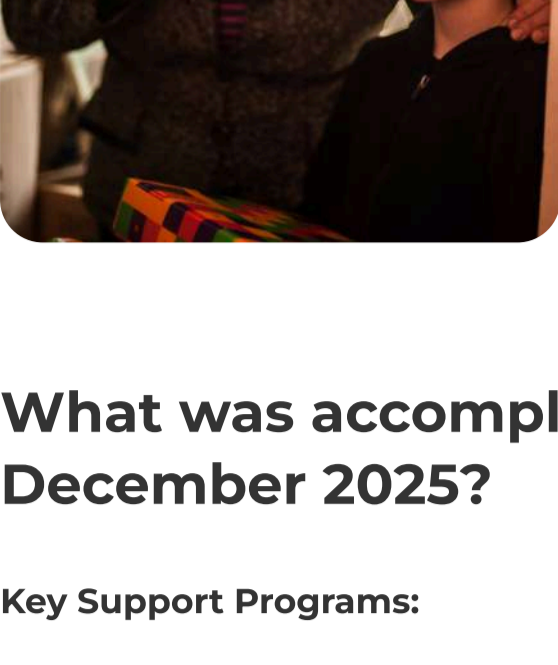
# Activity Report of the "Yad Yitzhak" Charitable Foundation for October – December 2025

Thank you for your trust, responsiveness, and participation.

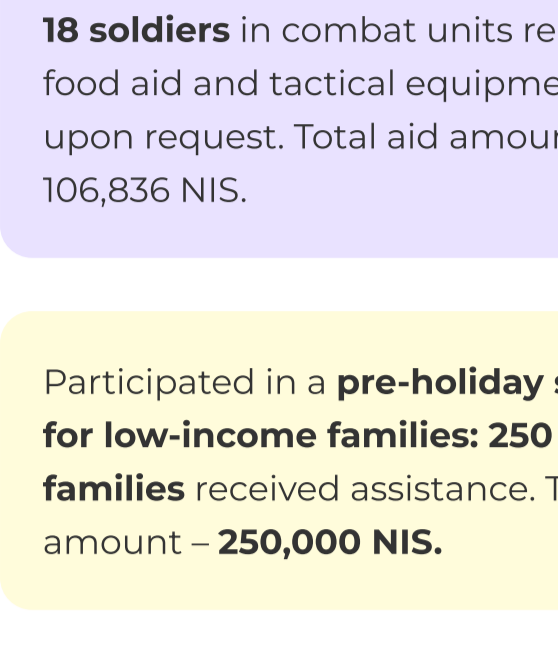
## Highlights of the 4th Quarter:



✓ We launched an in-person financial literacy course for "golden age" repatriates. During the reporting period, 45 repatriates attended. The launch of four more new groups is scheduled for January 2026.



✓ On the 2nd candle, we visited 10 checkpoints in Gush Etzion to wish our soldiers a happy holiday, bringing traditional donuts, hot pizza, and drinks.



✓ We lit the 4th Hanukkah candle in Kibbutz Ein HaShlosha — one of the communities closest to Gaza, whose residents had just begun returning home after two years of evacuation. It was not just a festive evening, but a warm and significant step towards returning to normal life.



✓ And on the 6th candle, our colleagues went to the homes of single-parent families to wish a happy holiday to children raised by single moms or dads, bringing them a sense of celebration and care.

Participated in a **pre-holiday sale for low-income families: 250 families** received assistance. Total amount – **250,000 NIS**.

**Sukkot:** During the holiday, **86 families** received financial assistance totaling **62,240 NIS**.

**Targeted Assistance:** As part of individual support, we provided targeted financial assistance to **25 families** totaling **128,190 NIS**.

Hosted a **Shabbaton for lone soldiers. 70 soldiers** were able to participate. The Foundation raised funds and financed this program for **49,660 NIS**.

**Rapid Response Teams:** This quarter, we supported civilian rapid response teams operating in coordination with the Israel Police. Assistance was received by **80 volunteers** totaling **111,673 NIS**.

## Hanukkah:

01. On the second candle of Hanukkah, we visited **10 checkpoints in Gush Etzion and congratulated our soldiers** on the holiday. We brought traditional donuts, hot pizza, and drinks.

02. We **celebrated the fourth Hanukkah candle in the settlement of Ein HaShlosha, the closest kibbutz to Gaza**. Its residents had just begun returning to their homes after two years of evacuation. This was not just a holiday, but a step towards life.

03. On the 6th candle, our colleagues **went to the homes of single-parent families and congratulated children being raised by single moms or dads on the holiday**. In total, we were able to support **150 families**. The total amount of aid was **49,430 NIS**.

## Own Initiatives of the "Yad Yitzhak" Foundation

Beyond regular or emergency assistance to those in need, the "Yad Yitzhak" Charitable Foundation is actively developing systemic initiatives aimed at qualitatively improving the level of aid provided, or facilitating the adaptation of new repatriates and enhancing their financial literacy.

We stand by our beneficiaries not only to help them overcome current hardships but also to empower them to build their future with confidence.

## "Smart Chesed" Program

The **"Smart Chesed"** program is aimed at providing legal assistance, facilitating the processing of benefits and entitlements, as well as offering comprehensive social support to families and individuals facing difficult life situations.

The project continues to help beneficiaries receive not only one-time assistance but also continuous systemic support: processing benefits, securing entitled payments, avoiding unnecessary expenses, and understanding their rights.

**Actual assistance** provided under the project for the 4th quarter of 2025 amounted to **802,600 NIS**.

Long-term confirmed benefit (beyond 1 year) is another **120,000 NIS**.

**Potential assistance** for other submitted applications may reach an additional **264,000 NIS**.

## Financial Adaptation: Step by Step

### "Learn to Count Again" Financial Literacy School

In the reporting quarter, **690 people** visited the school's website, of whom **49** completed the course online.

In the 4th quarter of 2025, we launched an in-person financial literacy course for "golden age" repatriates. During the reporting period, it was attended by 45 participants. In November, 2 groups started: in Ma'ale Adumim and in Pisgat Ze'ev (Jerusalem), and 4 groups are already scheduled for January 2026. The course also continues to accept applications in the online format.

In total, 94 people completed the financial adaptation course during the reporting period. Expenses for the financial literacy school amounted to **52,388 NIS**.

## "Cozy Shekel" Telegram Channel

Over 3 months, **1,000 people** joined the channel; the subscriber count reached **11,413**.

During the quarter, we gathered 513.8 thousand views and held 6 webinars, in which 667 people participated.

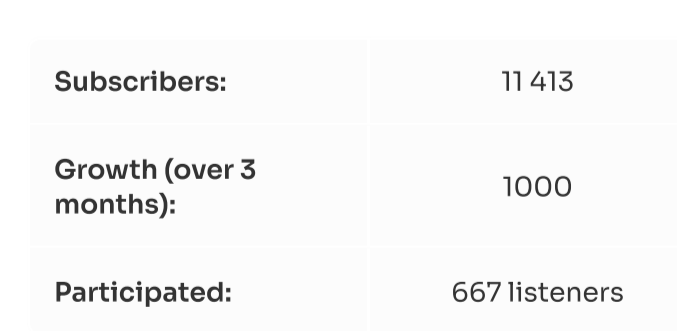

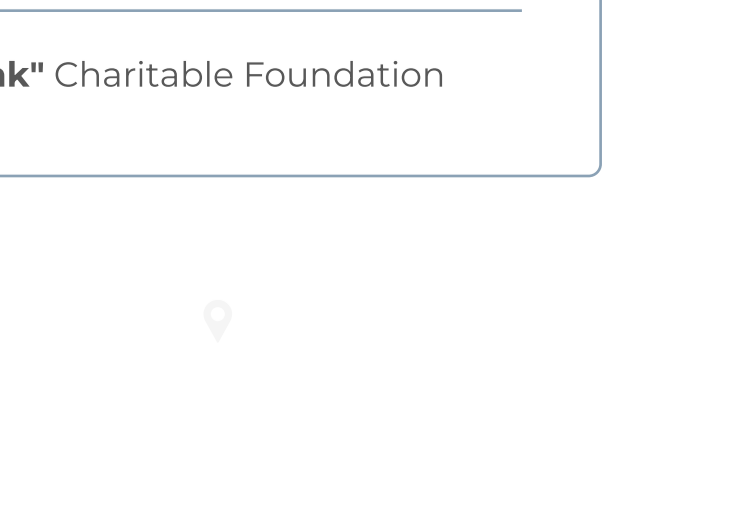
