During April 2024, we completed numerous significant projects:



Passover Fundraising:

We raised a total of **83,789.20 shekels**, which were distributed to needy families to celebrate Passover.



Trip to Ofakim:

The Foundation team visited the city of Ofakim, which was affected by the terrorist attack on October 7th. We distributed food baskets worth **18,000 shekels** to pensioners and the needy.

Development of the "Learn to Count Anew" Online School: We continue the professional online course to increase the financial literacy of new immigrants and their adaptation to life in Israel. Three out of five video modules have already been published and are available for students to study. **A total of 17,965.1 shekels has been invested in the development of the school.**

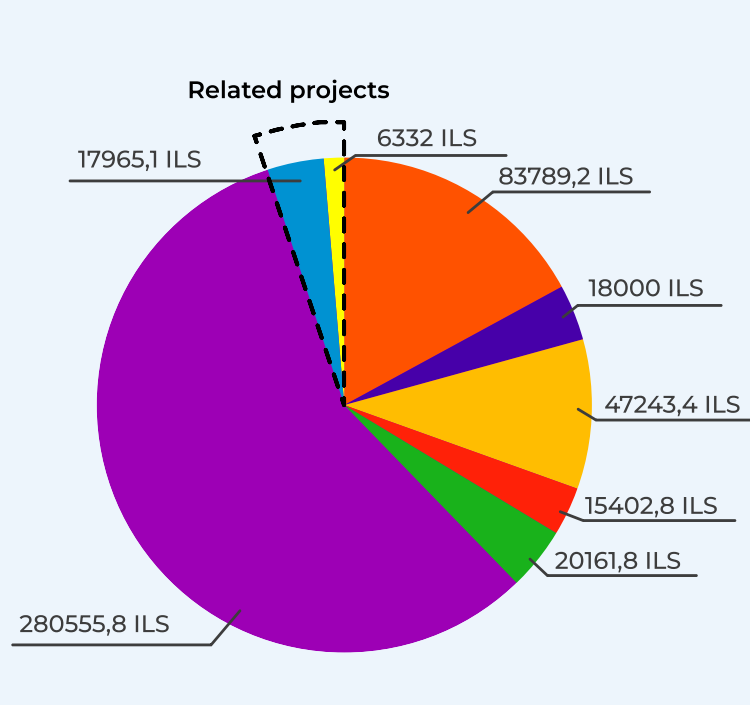

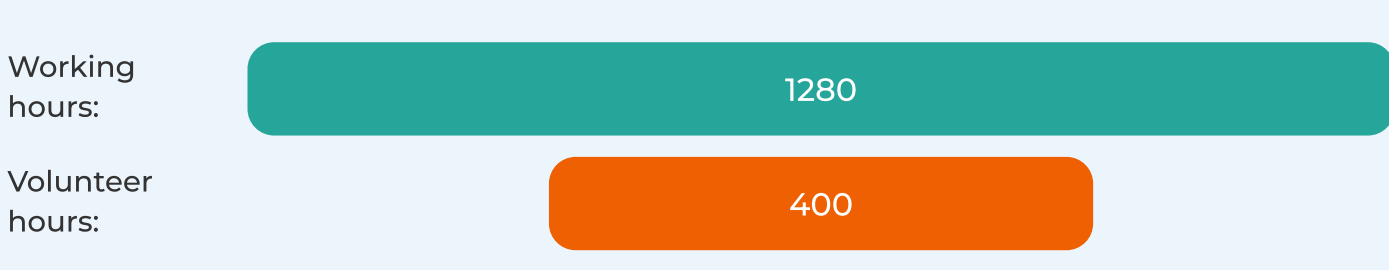

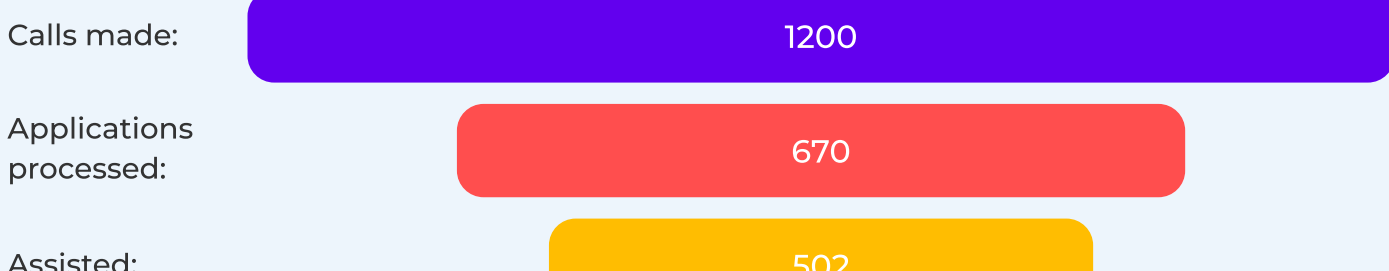
